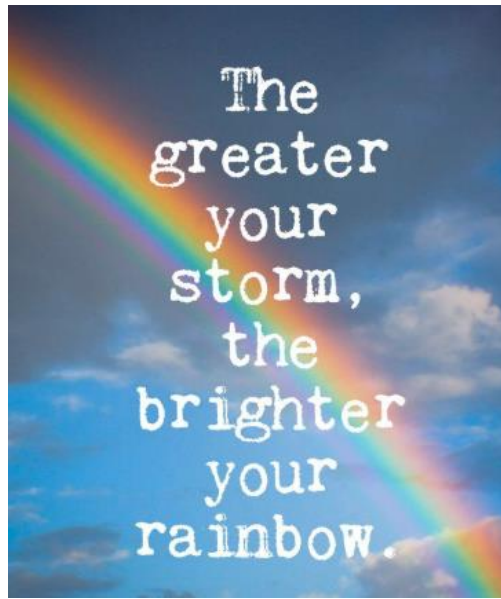


Enterprise Newsletter Summer 2020
