

Water, Water Everywhere!

History:

We will be looking at Ancient Egypt; and how this civilisation was able to thrive thanks to the River Nile.

They will research the Pharaohs, the pyramids, what happens when Egyptians die, how life was different for different people in Ancient Egypt and a quick look at the life of Tutankhamun.

Enrichment:

This half term Year 3 and Year 4 will be taking part in Forest Schools every Wednesday. For this, the children will need.

English:

We will be starting the half term by reading The Water Horse, this classic tale will be our focus that we will base our own narrative writing around,

We will also be looking at Poems with a structure. We will be focusing on the key features in Haikus and limericks before choosing our favourite to create our own, based on our topic work.

We will finish the half term by focussing by looking at non-fiction information booklets. We will be looking at the grammar skills involved in writing them and the content they need to include.



Geography

We will be starting the half term by looking at the water cycle. We will learn what it is and why it is important to all living things.

We will then move on to look at rivers. How they are formed, and the journey they take on their way to the sea.

Computing:

This half term the children will be looking at digital research. They will learn about Boolean operators and how webpages are made.

Science:

In science we will be looking at states of matter; Solids, liquid and gasses. The children will explore the properties of each state helping them to identify them in everyday life.

We will kick off our science this half term with a WOW slime investigations asking ourselves, what is it? Is it solid or liquid?
