Sparks might fly



- Our first half term theme is Sparks might fly. Our half term is full of recovery activities and PSHE.
- This theme looks at the science of Electricity, building circuits in DT and historical inventions focusing on inventions from the Victorian era.
- In English we look at Explanation Texts, Fantasy Stories and Play Scripts.
- In Maths we are beginning with place value before moving on to addition and subtraction.

Sparks Might Fly!



English

Our half term of English will begin with a dive into Explanation texts. We will be looking at the features used in this text before writing, recording and publishing our explanation text for others to watch.

We then move on to Phillip Pullman's 'Firework maker's daughter'. We will be using this as our theme novel to guide our own adaptations of the story.

We will finish the half term with film and play scripts. We will be learning the features and having a go at writing our own!

Science

This half term it is Electric! We will be learning all thing Electricity. We will be learning what electricity is, how it moves and most importantly the dangers of electricity. We will investigate different sources of electricity, its conductors and insulators.

The children will be using practical equipment to build a circuit and to find faults in circuit.

Maths

In Maths this half term it's all about place value, addition and subtraction. We will be recovering what we can remember from last year and adding this year's objectives.

History

This half term we will be looking at being our best selves, the importance of self-worth and having a growth mind set.

In DT we will be using our science knowledge to design and build a torch.

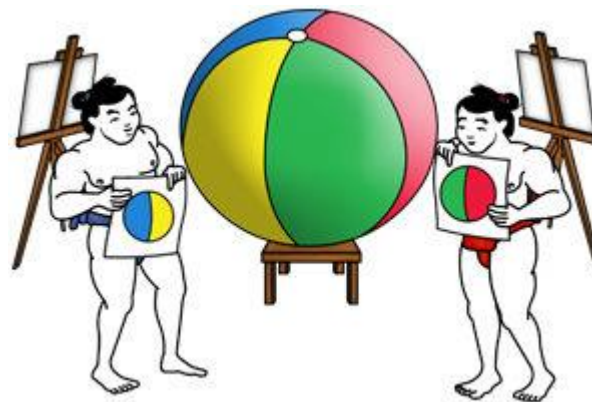
French

- After Christmas we hope to have swimming lessons.

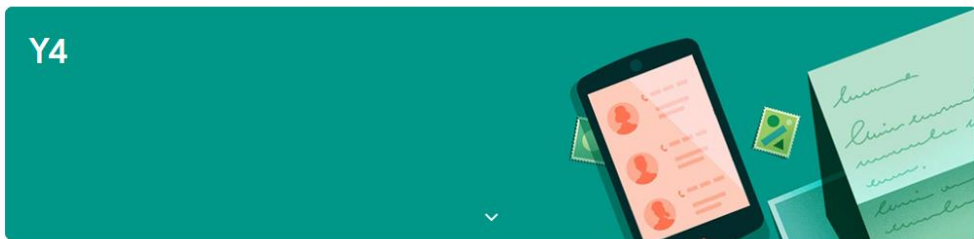
Times Tables Check – Y4
