Enrichment Activities:

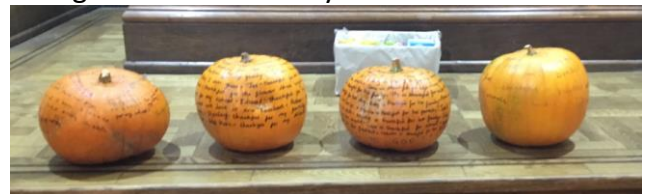
Bikeability – Year 6 have learnt the importance of visual checks and signalling when out on the
