Pentecost Party: This afternoon we have had a Pentecost Party in our bubbles. The children played pass the parcel and enjoyed party treats.

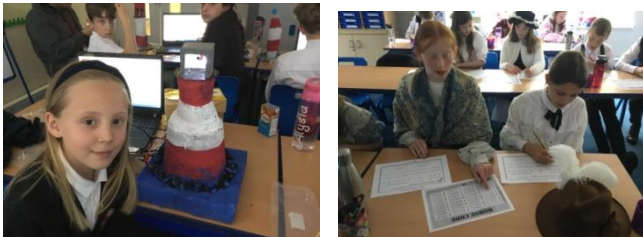
