
Enterprise Class Meet The Teacher Evening



P.E. Homework and Reading




- Our P.E days are Wednesday and Thursday. Mrs Horn will teach one unit on a Wednesday and Miss Topping another on a Thursday.



















Class Dojo and Website






- Class Dojo is used for positive communication.
