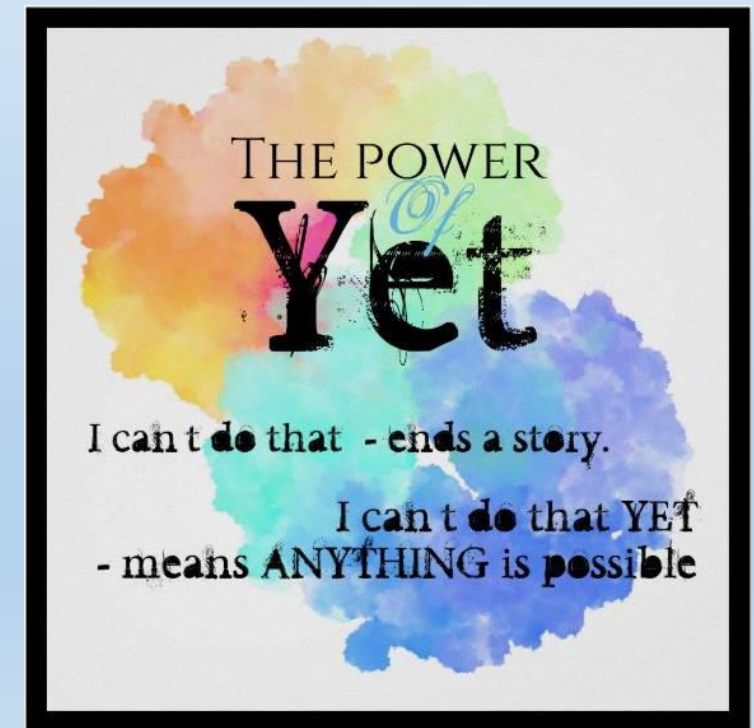




Enterprise Class Meet The Teacher Evening

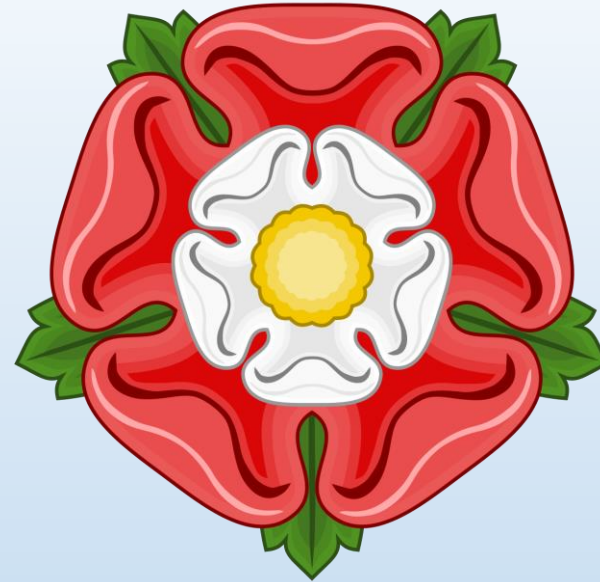

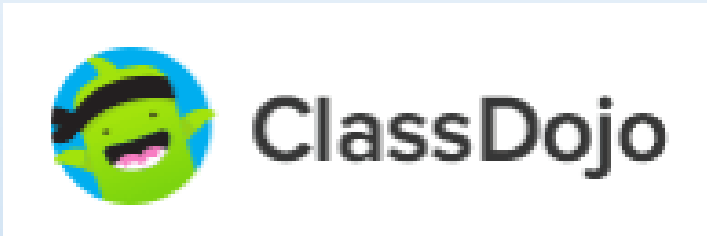
