School Council: Would like you thank you for all your support today raising money for Macmillan Cancer support.

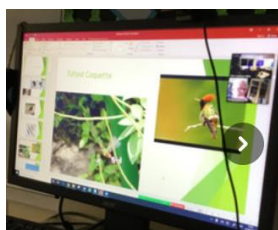
In school this week:

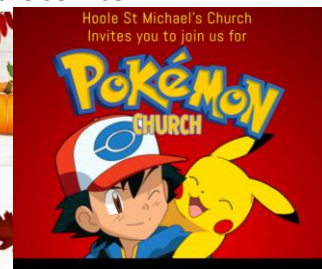
