English: Active Learners/Confidence

We are beginning our half term with a poetry unit focusing on the poem Space Walking. We will look at adjectives, rhyme, and write/innovate our own verse for the poem. In WW1 week we will be writing letters home from the trenches. We will then move on to stories with a familiar setting (this time it's space!) and children will write their own innovated story. Finally, we will end the half term with a non-chromoligical report, as you've probably guessed, about space! Children will look at statements and questions, focusing on the features of this non-fiction text type.

Maths:

Each morning we will do our daily Fluency Frenzi session, securing our number facts and showing variation. This half term the children will be looking at addition and subtraction. The children will show **Growth Mindset** when tackling problems and be **bold, courageous and confident** learners.

Art/DT:

Projects on a page or focus artists.

This half term the children will practise the skill of printing linked to Christmas craft. Within DT we are making a freestanding structure in the form of a rocket! We will use the skills of design, measuring, marking out, cutting and finishing techniques.



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P.E: Confidence, courageous, partnerships

In our PE topics this half term, we will be doing Fundamental movement skills, such as balancing, jumping, dodging and ball skills. We will also do gymnastics, learning pathways and sequences.

In both of these PE units, the children will have to show great **confidence** and **courage** to try these different movements and skills. The children will continue to work on their **sportsmanship**, **listening** and **perseverance** within every PE lesson.

Geography/History: Inquisitive, compassionate, diversity.

Led by discovery and enrichment – thirst for knowledge

This half term in geography, we will explore and observe our local environment. We will look at the key human and physical features of our local area, including weather patterns. We will locate these features on maps, using aerial photographs. As historians, we will learn about significant people in the past. We will link this to our local area, when looking at Jeremiah Horrocks and also significant events in time.

Music: creativity and freedom

Nativity songs - learning lyrics, rhythms, dances and instrumental accompaniment.

Science: Active learners/partnerships

In our science this half term, we will be looking at light and astronomy with a particular focus on seasonal change. We will observe weather patterns. Observe and describe changes across the four seasons, with a focus on autumn. Children will discuss the changes in weather associated with the seasons and how day length varies.

IT: Meaningful progression of skills

In our IT lessons this term, we will continue looking at e-safety (how to use technology sensibly and safely.) we will also be looking at making our own space-themed imovie trailer! The children will learn to stop, pause, record and retrieve audio files.
