Atlantis: A super successful Brew, Book and Biscuit. The children (and staff) loved having parents in again.

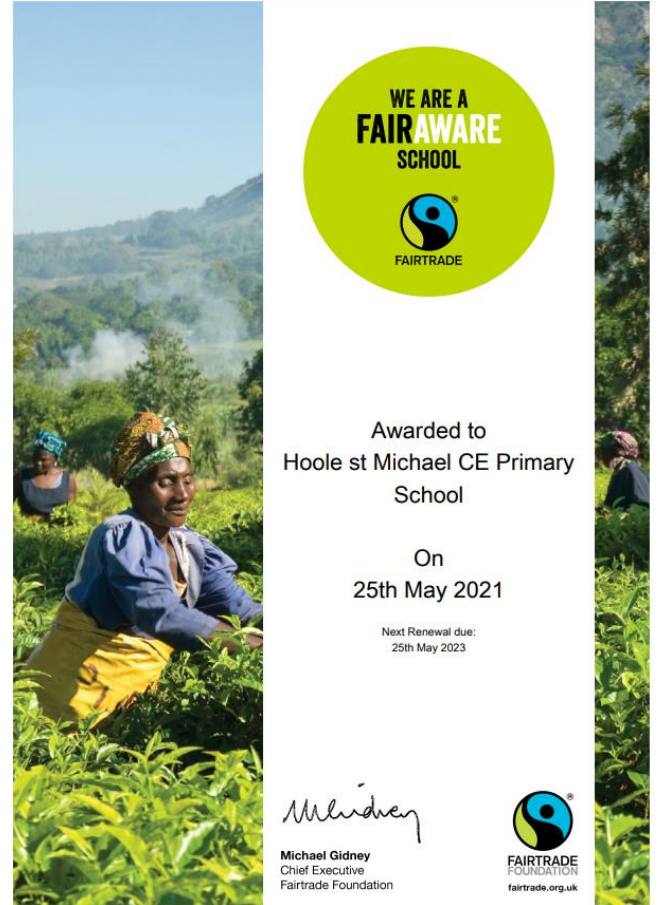


Enterprise: The fire department visited; they spoke to the children all about fire safety.

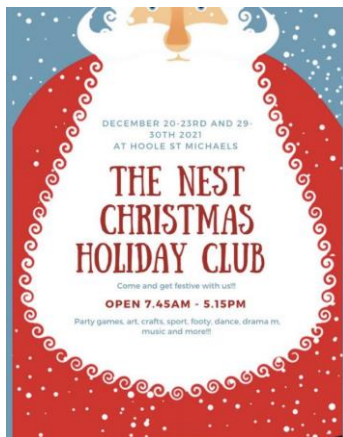
Congratulations to Endeavour Class and Mrs Cookson who have achieved the Fairaware Award for their championing Fair-trade produce in school.
