We will be holding an important meeting for all parents of children in Y2. This meeting will provide you with information regarding end of KS1 SATs.

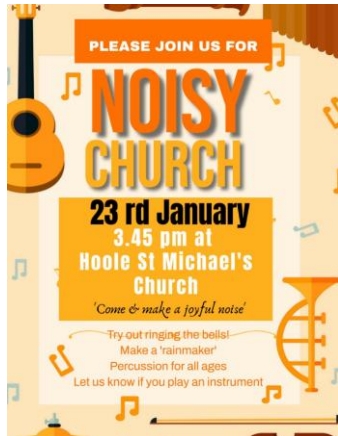
School Governor Vacancies
