Atlantis: Cricket coaches in to do a workshop with the children.

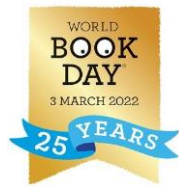
Enterprise: This week Enterprise have been busy rehearsing for their Let's go sing performance next week.
