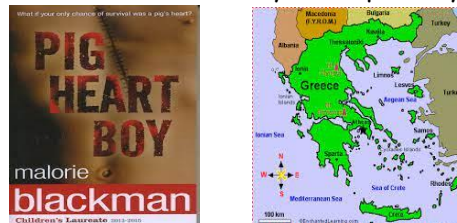
Art: African Art Week Active Learners Confidence

Maths: Confidence, Resilience, Active Learners

Year 5: We will be looking at measurements and converting between units before moving on to looking at volume, area and perimeter. We will finish the year by looking at Roman Numerals. Arithmetic and fluency sessions will continue daily.
