# Joint Projects

## SPIRITUALITY DAYS ON 9<sup>TH</sup>-11<sup>TH</sup> JUNE

**Discovery:** Looking at apples and how they represent the Holy Trinity. We then made pictures with them and labelled our pictures.

**Atlantis:** As part of Spirituality week, we looked at the Holy trinity, we discussed the various parts of the trinity and understood that God is one but comes in 3 parts. We looked at examples of when we have witnessed these 3 parts and focused on writing about the Jesus' Baptism. We then created a diagram of the Holy Trinity and used pictures to show examples of each of the 3 parts.

**Enterprise:** This week Enterprise have explored the Trinity in lots of ways, we created sculpture, wrote song lyrics, created mobiles and reflected by asking big question in our big question bowl!

**Endeavour:** We have been focusing on how the Trinity is represented in pictures and words. We have looked at Old and New Testament stories to explore the nature of God. It was decided that God in his 3 parts is unpredictable, powerful, gentle, creative and trustworthy. We made Trinity sculptures inspired by what God means to us.

Discovery	We have been looking at how one thing can be three parts/be seen in three different ways – an apple, water. We have listened to and learned 123 Jesus Loves Me. We have looked at what we are e.g. I am a sister, I am a friend, I am a footballer. We then looked at God: He is the Father, The Son and the Holy Spirit. The children will have watched videos, taken part in circle time and had chance to ask questions and make comments.	Explain to children why the Trinity is important in the Christian faith. Where they might see representations of the Trinity in church. Could the children go on a hunt to see if they can find any images/representations of God/Jesus/The Holy Spirit? Please share a Bible story with the children which you feel is relevant. Please could the children listen to a song linked to the Trinity.	12.50-1.50pm	
Atlantis	Story of John the Baptist Jesus' baptism 3 parts of the Holy Trinity/1 God Symbols	Reverend Ann/Liz to give the children an opportunity to watch a baptism. Ensuring they make links and ask questions throughout and making links to the referencing of the Holy Trinity.  At the end would it be possible to give the children a chance to talk and discuss with Reverend Ann/Liz about why the Trinity is written and spoken as it is rather than just saying God.  Please can the children work in small groups and verbally recount the story of Jesus' Baptism and can they make links to the Holy Trinity which we have covered earlier in the week. (Saw and heard) Assessment opportunity/sticky notes. After church, children will complete a table comparing a modern day Baptism and the Baptism of Jesus. (focus on differences and similarities)	10.45-11.45am	
Enterprise	During the week the children will have looked at Jesus' baptism and the Trinity being present. The children will have explored that the Trinity are three separate things yet are all God. The children will have looked at St Patrick's shamrock and created their own images to help them understand this concept. The children will have created mobiles using imagery they associate with each of the Trinity. The children will have explored the Trinity further by looking at the lyrics of Blessed Trinity. The children will have reflected on The Father, son and Holy Spirit being separate roles that God is – this children will have linked this to Mother, wife, daughter within the song's lyrics. The children will have created their own clay sculptures depicting their own personal versions of the Trinity.	Children to have an opportunity to watch a mock baptism. During this attention should be paid to the reference to the Trinity. Children to be given chance to discuss why they think the Trinity is listed rather than saying the word God. Children should be asked to work together to recap the story of Jesus' baptism they looked at earlier in the week. Children to then be given to record and discuss the similarities between a modern day baptism and the baptism of Jesus.	9.15-10.15am

**Enterprise:** We have been fact finding information about Henry VIII with Mrs Price.







# Children's Work
