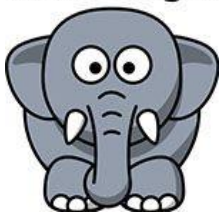

May we introduce our professional tuition service for schools and individuals. We have a great deal of experience teaching in primary schools nationwide. Our team are professional, fully qualified and all of our tutors are DBS checked.

At present there are spaces for the following after school clubs:

Percussion Club (60 minutes) = £4.95 per pupil, per lesson

To secure a session of tuition, forward payment for the whole half term (usually 5-7 weeks) is required. An advance payment is requested in order to secure a whole term of lessons for each pupil. We typically use online banking transfers for payment methods whereby the parents/schools pay us direct & then we pay the tutor. Invoices will be sent via email.
