Endeavour- As part of our Mindful March, we have been watching the clouds and noticing their differences.



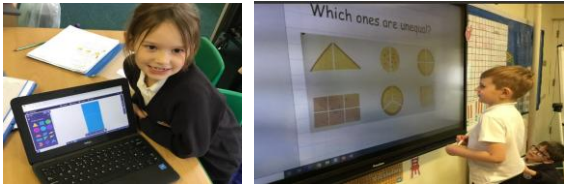
Enrichment
