**Endeavour Class** – **Jack** for working hard, focusing on his SATS revision and taking on feedback.



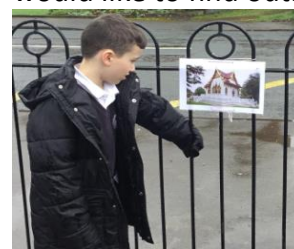
