



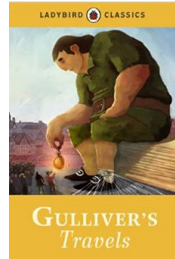

Maths:

In maths this half term, Year 4 will begin their unit on decimals and Year 3 will complete their unit on time. We will then look at mass, volume and length, linking these areas to our reasoning and problem solving strands and building upon prior learning.

During our fluency sessions, we will continue to work on our flexibility and efficiency within number.

Geography/History:

As part of our geography unit we will begin by exploring the Lake District. We will then explore the Italian lakes and make comparisons between the two. Children will explore a range of maps, globes and tourist brochures. We will learn new vocabulary linked to this unit, such as latitude, longitude, Equator and Northern Hemisphere.



PSHE

This half term we will look at expenses and the importance of saving money. We will discuss taxes and what they are. Children will work together and listen to other people's opinions throughout this unit. We will also continue with My Happy Mind.

Music

Within this theme, children will investigate famous European classical composers, including Maurice Ravel, Beethoven and Mozart.



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P.E: Confidence, courageous, partnerships

In our PE units this half term, the children will have to show great **confidence** and **courage**. The children will continue to work on their **sportsmanship**, **listening** and **perseverance** within every PE lesson. This half term the children will have a weekly swimming lesson as part of their PE lessons. The children will work on their water safety and ability to swim unaided.

Art:

As part of our art unit, children will explore the use of collage to create images. Children will use drawings and photocopied images to tear, cut and layer in order to create a piece of art work, such as the Eiffel tower or Notre Dame. We will also use an online collage maker to manipulate photographic images. Throughout the unit children will discuss and evaluate the work that they have done.

DT:

Within our DT theme, the children will design, make and evaluate a fabric container, to hold a passport, some money or a ticket. The children will explore different stitches and fastening techniques, then apply these different techniques when making their product.

Science: Active learners/partnerships In science this half term we will be finding out about the functions of our teeth and how our digestive system works. Children will learn about the specific role each tooth has and the importance of looking after our teeth. We will then move on to our digestive system and investigate the role of each organ within this system.

The children will create their own model digestive system. They will work collaboratively to make their model and record their work individually in books.

IT: Meaningful progression of skills

Within our IT lessons, we are going to link our work to art and use an online collage maker to create our own art work. We will also complete a new programming unit. Children will explore the use of infinite loops to create an animation.
