Our Class Expectations.





- We have high expectations of the children, in preparation for the upper juniors. We know their potential, and we expect their best at all times. In everything.
- We made class rules together and our class display focuses on the attributes we focus on every day with our children.

•Year 3 is a big jump and we are promoting children's independence.







- TT Rockstars and Numbots- 3 x a week for 10 minutes.
 Spellings sent home on a Friday and tested the following Friday. New books this year!
- •CGP books will start to go home on a Tuesday and will need to be handed back in on/or before the following Monday.
- •Reading daily 10 minutes at a time.
- •Additional pieces may come home linked to topic work or specific needs.









We will continue to do daily fluency sessions that build our mental recall, speed and accuracy with number.
Maths lessons will be taught daily with a huge emphasis on practical learning and application of number. We ask the children to explain their thinking, spot patterns, find the odd one out and make connections within all aspects of mathematics.

•We use key representations to teach maths, such as the part whole model, bar model, base ten, number line, place value counters.



English



- This year we are putting a HUGE focus on spelling and grammar. As well as handwriting and presentation.
- •Their creativity and imagination is wonderful, but they need to slow down and ensure they are ticking all the grammar and spelling objectives.
- All children will have spellings tailored to what they need to work on.
- Some children will access Nessy (in class and at home).
- Reading continues to be a focus.
- •We do two shared sessions a week.
- •As much home reading as possible, is hugely beneficial.
- The children have three taught spelling lessons (rules which we use for home spellings).

•We do however, promote independent super spellers daily!







In Enterprise, we also focus on having a growth mindset. Pulling on their positive pants and having a good go!
