Hello and welcome back to a new academic year in Enterprise! We are so excited to get started on a year of fabulous learning with your superstars! Our first topic,


'Terrible Tudors' will be a great one; we have lots of fun things planned and are looking forward to sharing them with your children.

This half term, our mornings are starting as we mean to go on with fluency, maths, grammar, English. Guided reading/spelling will be part of our afternoon session. We have so much to fit in! For our first week, each afternoon we will spend some time focusing on PSHE and developing the children's inner strength.



As we often do, we are linking our learning to a story - ours is 'The Bad Seed' - where a seed makes bad choices. We are going recognise his weaknesses, try to spot his strengths, look at consequences and how he comes well (then apply this mind-set

to us and our lives!).



As part of our Terrible Tudors topic, we will be learning about King Henry V111, where the children will delve into what life was like during his reign in Britain. We will look at the War of the Roses, as

part of our local study, and how Henry became king. In English, we will be studying folk tales, poems and biographies. In Maths, we are looking at numbers to 1000 and 10 000 and addition and subtraction. Alongside all this we will be enriching the children with RE, French, music, computing, PSHE and PE and science!

- SPAG homework will go home/set on a Monday.
- Spellings will be sent out every Friday in a spelling book. These will be based on the spelling rules taught that week. Please practise your child's words with them and send the book back as tests will be recorded in this book for you to see © Tests will be the following Friday giving all children the full week and weekend to learn their spellings.
