



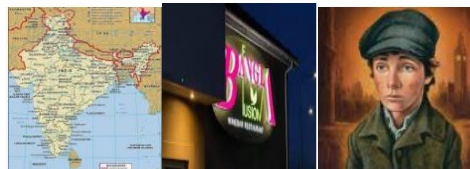

The half term begins with novel on a theme - Windrush Child. After this, our Bombay dreams are **coming to life** with a trip to India! We will begin with Cloud Tea Monkey, a **story of survival** and magic. We will be exploring high quality descriptions and writing our own versions of the story. We will then take a trip to London to meet Oliver Twist. We will **consider how the setting has changed** based on location and time period.

Maths: Confidence, Bold, Active Learners

This half term we will be focusing on **multiplication and division**. We will be starting with factors, common factors, multiples and common multiples. Prime numbers, squares and cubes will follow. We will then move on to formal calculations. Year 6 will explore further how this links to scale factors, ratio and proportion. In fluency sessions, we will be working flexibly and efficiently, starting with compensation. We will be using factors and connections we see to calculate.

History and Geography: Fusion, Empire and Privilege

Geography: We will continue our **exploration** of the world with a focus on India. We will **explore** the physical and human features of this country. We will also be looking at the **food miles** of our favourite foods.

History Enrichment: What was the British Empire? How did that change when Queen Victoria died? What was British rule like in India? How did Indian troops support Britain during World War 1?
