Enrichment

Whole School: This week it has been our WW1 Week. We have enjoyed learning about WW1 as well as developing our Art Skills. This morning we went to church for our Remembrance Service. We finished our week with a poppy party! Sharing our work and sing war songs together.

Discovery: We have had so much fun learning about World War 1 from making our own poppy badges, biscuits and creating wreaths.

Atlantis: This week, we loved talking to the members of parish and church to learn about people from Much Hoole who fought and died in WW1.

Enterprise: We have learnt about why the war began and how it ended. We have written prayers for the soldiers to attach to our poppy wreath, we have learnt the song 'Keep the Home Fires Burning' and we have linked our grammar and guided reading to our WW1 week.





Endeavour: Our work has been focused around our class novel 'The Skylarks' War.' We have used the A-Z of World War One and the novel side by side to learn about life in the trenches, the location of Flanders Field, the contribution of troops of the Empire and finally Armistice. We have written in role as various characters and also had our own go at writing part of the story. During our afternoon sessions, we have also learnt about the life of World War One nurse Edith Cavell.



Windrush: Today we have had visitors from the Preston Windrush Society, who came to talk to us about their experiences growing up in the UK. Their families came from Dominica and Antigua in the 1960s. Our Head Boy and Head Girl then presented them with a Black Poppy Rose wreath for remembrance to acknowledge the contribution of the Caribbean troops in the wars.

New Ways November:

Discovery: We went outside and loved looking at the changes in our outdoor area. Millie enjoyed leaf jumping in the piles of leaves which had been brushed up. **Atlantis:** This week we have been curious with our learning all about WW1 and life in the trenches.

Enterprise: We have been looking for new reasons to be hopeful, even in tough times (just like the soldiers). **Endeavour:** This week we have been curious, learning about new and inspiring topics.

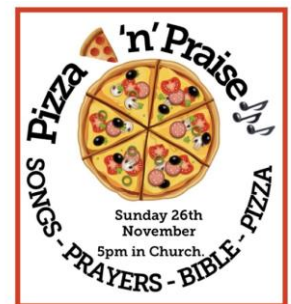
