Enterprise: Do something playful outdoors!

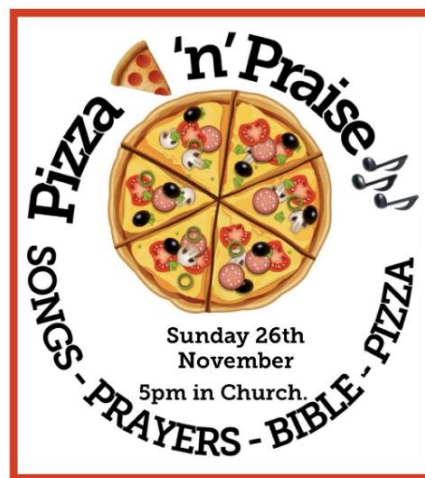
Endeavour: We have been doing something different – trying new things and exploring new tastes!
