Literacy - reading and writing confidence:

Once Upon A Time : As we journey through the land of fairy and traditional tales we meet characters from the following stories : The Gingerbread Man, The Enormous Turnip, Rapunzel and the Great Fairytale Disaster, Little Red Riding Hood, Peter and the Wolf and Jack and the Beanstalk.

We will be focussing we are encouraging children to write for different purposes writing Easter/Mother's Day cards, postcards, lists, stories, recipes etc. We are encouraging children to begin to write in full sentences using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. We will be planning lots of opportunities for role play through the use of our focus texts using this to develop language. We will continue our reading journey together using phonic knowledge to read with independence. During this half term, we continue on Phase 3! They are growing in **confidence** with their reading and writing skills.

Our writing focus continues to be on developing **resilience** to have a go at writing simple labels, captions and simple sentences using their phonic knowledge.

COEL: The focus of this half term is on **motivational** skills digging deep in our bucket of **courage**. Through the use of **Growth Mindset** we will encourage the children to keep on trying as they set themselves goals.

Maths mastery- having confidence and being resilient

Our day will always begin with 'Fluency Frenzy!' We love singing number songs, counting together and having fun together. This half term, we develop our understanding of numbers to 10. We focus on composition, comparison, representation, conceptual subitising and number bond facts within 10.

Linked to our work in our 'Once Upon A Time' topic we look at lengths and heights along with sequencing time events.

Understanding the world:

We will be learning about the season of Spring time, thinking about new life, lifecycles and planting beans linked to our Jack and The Beanstalk week.

We will also be learning through play and exploration using scientific questioning skills such as how can we help the gingerbread man float?

Physical Development- confidence, partnership, strong relationships:

During this half term, we focus on developing the core strengths to enable your child to develop both gross motor and fine motor skills. This will be done through our weekly PE sessions (Thursday), Tots On Tyres sessions, co-operative play, woodland sessions, learning through play outdoors along with fine motor skills activities.
