Atlantis: We loved exploring our Sense Station in Mr Bacon's science lesson this week. We really enjoyed putting our senses to the test!

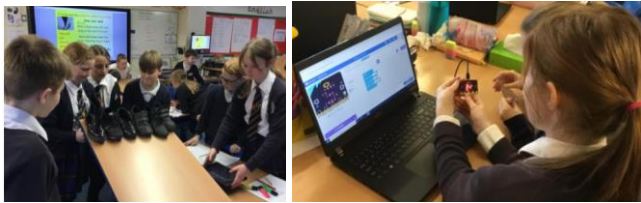
Enterprise: In Geography, we looked at our place within the world. Fitness Fun!
