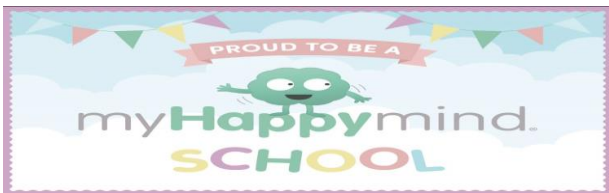
### What Would Jesus Do Awards:
