What Would Jesus Do Awards:

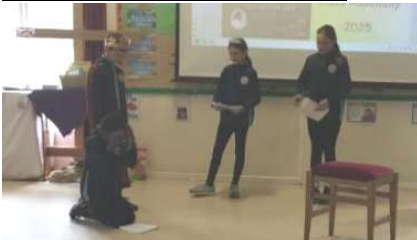
Honey Bees and Discovery- Henry for showing his Christian value of courage and having a really good go at riding the bikes in Tots on tyres.
