Maths: Resilience and Confidence

This half term Year 4 will be developing their understanding of decimals, making links back to the work that we have done on fractions. Year 3 will be exploring mass and capacity, using their skills from previous units to work flexibly and apply their knowledge to real-life problems. Year 4 will also be working hard on their times tables ready for their check.

Science: Exploration. Sound.

In this unit, we will find patterns between the pitch of a sound and features of the object that produced it. Pupils will find patterns between the volume of a sound and the strength of the vibrations that produced it. We will know that sounds get fainter as the distance increases.

<u>P.E: Active learners, Partnerships</u> Tennis and rugby

<u>Music:</u> Body and Tuned Percussion. They will also use a mixture of body percussion and tuned percussion instruments as the children create their own rhythms of the rainforest,

<u>French: Thirst for knowledge, Language</u> <u>Confidence</u>

History: Resourceful Throughout this term, we are going to be learning about the Romans. We will begin to explore the buildings in Rome and use these as clues to explore how the Romans lived. We will explore the meaning of the words 'empire', 'invasion' and 'settlement'. Pupils will analyse the different reasons for the Roman invasion of Britain and explain how the Celts responded

IT: Meaningful progression of skills Creating Media- Photo editing.

DT: Growth Mindset- 2D to 3D.

During this unit of DT, pupils will design a product for a purpose, such as a purse for holding some coins, a case for carrying pencils, or a soft teddy to enjoy. They will then learn and practise the skill of stitching to create their 3D product.



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
