


Endeavour Newsletter Summer 2025


# English:

# • SATS Revision for Reading and Grammar

We will be revising each day in class for the reading and grammar tests, doing small focused snapshots of papers with the children. Before the Easter break, we sent home knowledge organisers that have an overview of what is needed for the Grammar test.



Booster sessions for the grammar and reading tests will continue to be held on Thursday nights from 3.20pm - 4pm.

### Spelling:

These will continue to come home weekly with tests on a Monday. We always revise these daily in class but this does not replace work at home. The spelling test in the SATS follows specific spelling rules that I sent home on the SATS information evening. I will also post these on Dojo.

### Maths:

Revision for the SATS will also take place in lessons, both in our Fluency Session and our main lesson. Booster will continue on a Tuesday night until the SATS apart from Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> April.
