

Literacy – reading and writing confidence: Our focus text for this half term is The Whale Who Wanted More. Our Honeybees outcome: To draw/paint/make a fish individually or in a small group and to be able to contribute orally to a short story about their fish. Our Reception outcome: To rewrite the story focussing on friendship. We will continue to focus on writing in full sentences using a capital letter and a full stop, writing using tricky words taught, use of a word mat and phonetically plausible spellings for new and unfamiliar words. We will continue to focus on listening and attention skills, maintaining attention and sitting for carpet time. We will continue our reading journey together developing a strong partnership between home and school. During this half term in phonics, we will finish Phase 3! We have already seen that the children's thirst for knowledge is evident in all that they do. They are growing in confidence with their reading and writing skills.

Our writing focus continues to be on developing **resilience** to have a go at writing simple labels, captions and simple sentences using their phonic knowledge.

<u>COEL</u>: The focus of this half term will be on Creating and Thinking Critically. During self-initiated play, at Forest School and during guided teacher led activities we will be encouraging the children to: show and talk about strategies; talk about how to do things focussing on problem-solving, thinking and learning. We will use our Growth Mindset skills to overcome barriers
