**Honey Bees and Discovery**- Show your appreciation for people who are helping others. **Atlantis-** Make time to do something playful just for the fun of it.


**Enterprise-** We have been finding joy in music, singing, play and dance. We have also focused on finding joy by listening to our friends and sharing with others.
