#### English: Courageous and Bold writers

This half term we will be **exploring** a non-fiction text on the Rainforest. Children will build on their prior knowledge of this biome and look at the features of this text type. Children will continue to apply their grammar sessions to independent writing and develop the skills of editing in order to improve. Guided reading sessions will have a focus on inference.

<u>Geography: Resourceful</u> Our theme in geography this half term is 'Where does our food come from?' Throughout this unit, children will identify which biomes grow which foods, and explain why. Pupils will look at the distance travelled by some foods and think about how to reduce our carbon footprint by sourcing foods locally. Pupils will then design and carry out a data collection to answer an enquiry question.
