English: *Courage, Adventure, Resilience & Hope*

We begin the year with a journey into the world of King Kong, exploring Anthony Browne's powerful retelling and discovering themes of courage, adventure, friendship and determination. Through vivid illustrations and rich language, we will consider the choices characters make when faced with fear, danger and the unknown. Moving on to America, we encounter Stanley Yelnats in our class novel, *Holes*. As Stanley faces the challenges of Camp Green Lake, we explore resilience, perseverance, justice and hope.

Maths: *Confidence, Resilience, Active Learners*

We will be starting the year with the **building blocks of maths** - the value of number. We will be **building our fluency skills** as well as our knowledge, working with increasingly larger numbers and negative numbers too. Moving on, we will be **cementing and applying** our skills with number through addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. In our daily fluency sessions, we will be focusing on these three key words: **flexibility, accuracy and efficiency**, with a theme of number.

Geography:

We start the year exploring what life is like in the Alps, using geographical vocabulary to locate the Alps and explore the physical and human features of this mountain region. We will investigate how people live and work in the Alps and how the landscape influences their lives

Science: Science this half term is all about light. We will begin by exploring how light travels and how we see objects, we will be encouraging children to question, discuss and make predictions. Art: This half term we are exploring 2D Drawing to 3D Making, inspired by the imaginative artwork of Anthony Browne. We will experiment with line, shape, texture and form, developing our ideas from drawings into 3D creations. We will work boldly and creatively, using our imagination to transform 2D artwork into exciting 3D pieces. '
